Objective of the Seminar

The doctoral seminar aims at providing the Early Stage Researchers (ESRs) with the opportunity to present their doctoral research progress and to receive feedback from the professors, legal scholars and other ESRs of the same Work Package (WP).

Preparation for the Seminar

As a preparation for the seminar, each ESR is required to submit a **substantial piece of writing** (preferably a draft chapter of the dissertation), which is planned to be the part of the 5th progress report to be submitted by the end of February 2020, together with an **outline of the doctoral thesis**, so that the readers can assess the writing by taking into consideration the structure of the whole dissertation. These documents should be sent via e-mail to the **commentator, other ESRs of the same WP and organisers** (e-mail address: jurgita.randakeviciute@ip.mpg.de) no later than **7 January 2020**.

Assignment for the Seminar

During the seminar, each ESR is expected to present the following aspects:

- (1) very short overview of the research objective of the doctoral thesis;
- (2) research question(s) to be answered in the doctoral thesis;
- (3) methodology used to answer the research question(s);
- (4) very short overview of the content of the submitted substantial piece of writing;
- (5) objective of the substantial piece of writing;
- (6) contribution of the substantial piece of writing to answering the research question(s);
- (7) methodology used for the preparation of the substantial piece of writing;
- (8) issues, if any, faced in preparing the substantial piece of writing;
- (9) any other aspects related to the substantial piece of writing the ESR would like to discuss.

Each presentation should not exceed 15 minutes. Slides and/or any other visual materials are optional.

Each presentation will be followed by an assessment, remarks and/or questions of the commentator and other ESRs of the same WP. Subsequently, a discussion will take place followed by questions and comments from other seminar attendees.
